Welcome to Footprints T&C, LLC (“we”, “us”, “our”). This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use, disclose, and protect information when you visit or interact with our website <https://footprintslearningacademy.com/> (the “Website”), including any forms, inquiries, or other features offered on the Website.

- No mobile information will be shared with third parties/affiliates for marketing/promotional purposes. Information sharing to subcontractors in support services, such as customer service is permitted. All other use case categories exclude text messaging originator opt-in data and consent; this information will not be shared with any third parties.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect the following types of information:

- **Contact Information:** When you use our contact or inquiry form (e.g. “Inquire Now”, scheduling a tour, or sending a message), we may collect personal details such as your name, email address, phone number, address, and any other information you choose to provide (e.g. child’s name, child’s birth date, required start date, message). <https://footprintslearningacademy.com/>
- **Optional Details:** Any additional information you provide voluntarily, such as child’s birth date, address, or special requirements. <https://footprintslearningacademy.com/>
- **Automatically Collected Data (if applicable):** If we use analytics or visitor-tracking tools (e.g. cookies, web beacons), we may automatically collect data such as IP address, browser type, pages visited, and time spent on the Website. *(Note: update this section depending on whether you actually implement cookies or tracking tools on your Website.)*

2. How We Use Your Information

We use collected information for the following purposes:

- To respond to your inquiries, schedule tours, or follow up on contact or registration requests you submit via the Website.
- To provide and manage our services: e.g., offering childcare and learning programs for children on the autism spectrum as described on the Website (enrollment, communication, therapy/ support coordination). <https://footprintslearningacademy.com/>

- To improve the Website, its usability, and user experience (if automatic tracking is in use).
- To fulfill any other purpose disclosed to you at the time you provide the information.

3. Data Sharing and Disclosure

We will **not** share, sell, rent, or trade your personal information with third parties — except in the following circumstances:

- With service providers or partners who assist us in delivering our services (e.g. therapists, support staff), **if and only if** it is required for the care, support, or therapy of the child, and with consent from the parent/guardian.
- If required by law, regulation, or legal process.
- When we believe it is necessary to protect the rights, property, or safety of our organization, our staff, users, or others.

If we do share personal information, we commit to applying reasonable safeguards and restricting access to only what is necessary.

4. Data Retention

We will retain your personal information only for as long as reasonably necessary to fulfill the purposes described above, unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law. Once the information is no longer needed, we will securely delete or anonymize it.

5. Security

We implement reasonable organizational, technical, and administrative measures designed to safeguard and protect your personal information from unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction. However, please be aware that no method of transmission or storage over the internet is 100% secure — we cannot guarantee absolute security.

6. Your Rights

Depending on your jurisdiction, you may have certain rights regarding your personal information, including but not limited to:

- The right to access the personal information we hold about you.
- The right to request correction or deletion of your personal data.
- The right to withdraw consent (where consent was used as the basis for processing).
- The right to object to certain processing activities or request restrictions.
